It is a "Film-making festival" for filmmakers and audiovisual artists who work in professional conditions under the supervision of outstanding artists and technicians on the best AV equipment available on the global market. During the Film Spring, we are stimulating the future of the industry on the basis of new trends, formats and new talents working in over 20 dedicated creative groups. We cooperate with over 60 leading companies and corporations of, which provide us equipment worth 3.5 million Euro.






The future of the AV industry is the common denominator of our courses. We teach and encourage participants to experiment and seek new linguistic solutions.





Our <u>Cinebus</u>, a mobile audiovisual studio it's a tool by which we developing the New Model of Sustainable and Green Film Production which aims to:

- -Reduction of film production costs. With the modern production model, the number of films made by debutants will significantly increase,
- -Facilitation of international coproduction, since frequently economic obstacles overwhelm the stakeholders from less wealthy countrie,
- -Improvement of the competitiveness in the European AV market through production intensification.
- -Propose the necessary changes for AV production in the EU.Remodeling the method of AV production can bring extremely positive effects in terms of quality of films and production costs. The young director after several years of study very often makes a bad first film not because he/she is not talented (prominent directors also make bad movies). The reason is often a system that works against him/her. MAKING OF
